

Empower Your Future: How the Career Empowerment Grant Works

Your Path to Education with Low-to-No Tuition Debt

What is the Career Empowerment Grant?

The Career Empowerment Grant works with your company's tuition benefits program to help you grow your skills without the need to borrow.

How is the Career Empowerment Grant Calculated?

The amount of tuition covered depends on your company's tuition benefits limit and the cost per credit hour.

Example of Grant Benefits:

- Undergraduate: If your organization offers at least \$5250 in Tuition
 Assistance, eligible employees could take up to 20 credit hours per year at the undergraduate level.
- Graduate: If your organization offers at least \$10,000 in Tuition Assistance, eligible employees could take up to 18 credit hours per year at the graduate level.

Who is eligible for the Grant?

To be eligible, you must meet your company's employment and tuition policy requirements. New and readmitted students are welcome, but you'll need to meet DeVry University (DVU) or Keller Graduate School admission requirements. This grant is only for employees, not for their family members.

How the Career Empowerment Grant Works

Are there other fees?

No. The application fee, book fees and any other student service fees are covered as part of the Career Empowerment Grant.

Can I take out student loans?

With the Career Empowerment Grant, in combination with your employer tuition benefits, there is no need to borrow.

Which Programs Are Covered?

All DVU and Keller undergraduate and graduate programs qualify for the grant. The credit hours you can take each year depend on your program and the tuition cost.

What if I leave my company?

If you leave the company, you may still be able to maintain eligibility for the Career Empowerment Grant, but you will be responsible for making student payments on your student account and keeping your account current. If you do not make student payments or are delinquent, you would lose eligibility for the grant going forward.

What if I go beyond the Tuition Benefits amount?

You can adjust your course load to stay within your company's tuition limit. If you go over, you'll need to pay any extra costs.

When is tuition due?

DeVry offers deferred billing. You submit your grades to get reimbursed, so you have longer to pay your tuition and fees.


What if I need to pause my studies?

No worries! You can pause for up to two sessions a year if needed.

What if I do not pass or withdraw from a class?

If you don't pass or withdraw, you'll be responsible for any balance on your student account. You can remain in the grant program as long as your balance is paid prior to the start of the subsequent session of classes.
